### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

The Assistive Devices Program (ADP) helps people with long-term physical disabilities get needed equipment and supplies (wheelchairs, prosthetic limbs etc.). The program covers over 8,000 separate pieces of equipment and supplies.

ADP pays up to 75% of the cost of the equipment or contributes a fixed amount.

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?**

You can apply for assistance if :

- you are an Ontario resident with a valid health card; **and**
- you have a long-term physical disability (lasting 6 months or longer)
